

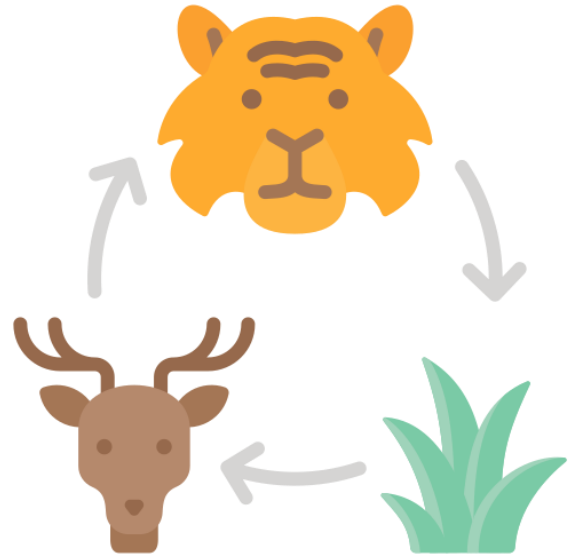
Biology Bricks: Activity

Food Chains using Concrete Materials

You want to build a food chain to represent how it looks in front of you. This activity sheet will help you find a way. Just follow the directions.

You will need:

- Paper cups/Ice lolly sticks
- Somewhere to put the ice lolly sticks (if you choose to use these)
- Pictures of your food chain (the animals or organisms that are included)
- Sellotape
- Scissors
- String (optional)



Instructions

1. Cut out all your food chain organisms/animals that are included. These will be needed for a visual representation.
2. Sellotape them to the paper cups or ice lolly sticks (a tray with soil or compost in it would be a good idea – you can then use this to plant some seeds or something later).
3. Place them visually in line for the representation of the food chain.
4. For use of the optional string, you could attach the string to one side of each part of the food chain and get the students to link them up correctly. The idea being they learn about the food chain as they create it.
