Cancer

A series of conditions that make cells in the body grow uncontrollably.



Tumour

A type of growth of cells that are sometimes able to spread around the body.



Malignant

A type of tumour that can be harmful and will spread from one place in the body to the next.



Benign

A type of tumour that is not generally harmful and can be removed with simple surgery once only.



Breast Cancer

A type of cancer that can affect men and women and is more common in women. It affects the mammary glands.



Bowel Cancer

A type of cancer that can happen in both women and men and that affects the internal bowels of the body.



Prostate Cancer

A type of cancer that is more dominant in men than women, prostate cancer affects the prostate gland beside the bladder.



Bone Cancer

A type of cancer that can affect men and women and affects the cells in your bones.



Blood Cancer

A type of cancer that can affect both men and women and that affects the red blood cells in your circulatory system.



Throat Cancer

A type of cancer that affects men and women and affects the throat. It can affect several parts of the throat, including the thyroid, windpipe and oesophagus.



Radiotherapy

Several types of treatment for cancers, radiotherapy is an early treatment method for people with Stage 1 or 2 cancer.



Chemotherapy

The most well-known treatment for cancers, chemotherapy is a type of medication that kills cancerous cells.



Treatment

For cancer, there are different types of treatment, including radiotherapy, chemotherapy, tablet or injection, and surgery.



Surgery

Surgery can be made on a person that has cancer, which can clear them of it, or remove parts of the cancerous tissues.
