Patau's Syndrome

Patau's syndrome is caused by a baby having an extra chromosome 13 present. It can cause serious issues, and is often not outlived by more than a year's life.



Cleft Lip

A baby with a cleft lip can have Patau's syndrome, and is one of the symptoms.



Chromosome 13 (Trisomy 13)

Babies with Patau's syndrome have an extra chromosome 13, or trisomy 13.



Brain Dysfunction

A baby with Patau's syndrome can have serious brain dysfunction as one of the symptoms.



Abnormal Eyes

Patau's syndrome can cause abnormal-looking eyes as one of the symptoms of the condition.



Small Head

Patau's syndrome can cause the head to be significantly smaller than a regular baby.



Malformed

Patau's syndrome can cause the body to be malformed in many ways. It is one of the symptoms of the condition.



Birthmarks

Patau's syndrome can cause larger birthmarks, sometimes across the whole body, as part of the condition.
