Infertility

Infertility is the inability to fall pregnant or have a baby. It can be either men or women that can have it.



In Vitro Fertilisation (IVF)

IVF is a process where the semen is inserted to the egg in a laboratory, and placed back in the woman to have a pregnancy.



Treatment

IVF is a treatment that enables a couple who might otherwise be unable to have a baby, to fall pregnant, and is done through a laboratory.



Ovulation

Ovulation happens once a month, typically around 10-15 days after a period in a woman.



Hysterectomy

A hysterectomy is a procedure only undertaken if absolutely necessary. It removes the womb (uterus) from the female reproductive system.



Falling Pregnant

Falling pregnant happens when a male and female copulates. IT can happen quickly, or it can take some time, or not at all, for various reasons.



Endometriosis

Endometriosis is a condition where tissues similar to the lining of the uterus grow outside the womb. It has many symptoms, and can affect women of any age.



Operations

There are a series of operations that can be performed for IVF and endometriosis, including cutting away of the tissues or hysterectomy.



Surgery

Surgery is only ever carried out if there is no other option to treat the lack of pregnancy.

Other treatments are always considered first.



Polycystic Ovary Syndrome

This is a condition where the ovaries are surrounded by fluid-filled sacs that surround the eggs. It is painful and limits the ability to fall pregnant.
