Lesion

Lesions can severely hurt plants. They appear on the stems, leaves and other parts of the plant. They include wounds, ulcers, sores and tissue damages.



Disease

Plants can have similar types of diseases to humans, including viral, bacterial, fungal and protists.



Plants

The plants are what help us breathe, and generate oxygen. If a disease infects a plant, it can stunt growth, or limit the amount of photosynthesis that occurs.



Fungal

Plants can have fungal diseases, such as black spot on roses, which limit the amount of photosynthesis occurring.



Bacterial

A type of bacterial disease in a plant includes black rot, which is a type of bacterial disease that likes the warm and wet conditions.



Viral

A type of viral infection a plant can have is Tobacco Mosaic virus, or TMV. It can spread by contact, even through handling by human touch.



Protist

A protist disease in plants includes *Pyrrrophyta phylum*, which can affect water plants by covering an area and limiting the amount of photosynthesis happening under the surface.



Aphids

Small insects that can drain a plant of sap, aphids are also harvested by ants that collect the sap they remove and use it themselves.



Black Spot

A type of fungal disease that affects rose plants, and limits the amount of photosynthesis from happening.



Tobacco Mosaic Virus

A viral pathogen that spreads between plants through touch, Tobacco Mosaic Virus, or TMV, can severely affect a farmer's crops when spread around a larger area of plants.



Photosynthesis

The process that created the oxygen we need to breathe, it can be restricted by diseases that affect plants.



Pathogen

A cellular disease that infects a plant; similar to how they affect humans, pathogens can spread and multiply to become a nuisance for plants.
